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Tense

Present Indefinite

How to identify

हिंदी वाक्य की क्रिया के अंत में ता हैं / ती हैं / ती हूँ / ते हैं इत्यादि आता है। जैसे

- मैं PNB बैंक में काम करता हूँ।

Rules

Subject + 1st form of verb (s/es) + Object

Example

SUBJECT	VERB	REST OF THE SENTENCE
I	work	in PNB Bank.
You	work	in PNB Bank.
We	work	in PNB Bank.
They	work	in PNB Bank.
Rohan	works	in PNB Bank.
He	works	in PNB Bank.

Note: Here, with **Rohan and He**, s is added with first form of the verb.



Negative

Rules

Subject + Do/Does +Not + Object

Example

SUBJECT	NEGATIVE	VERB	REST OF THE SENTENCE
I	do not	work	in PNB Bank.
You	do not	work	in PNB Bank.
We	do not	work	in PNB Bank.
They	do not	work	in PNB Bank.
Rohan	does not	work	in PNB Bank.
He	does not	work	in PNB Bank.



Interrogative

Rules

Do/Does + Subject + Object

Example

INTERROGATIVE	SUBJECT	VERB	REST OF THE SENTENCE
Do	I	work	in PNB Bank.
Do	you	work	in PNB Bank.
Do	we	work	in PNB Bank.
Do	they	work	in PNB Bank.
Does	Rohan	work	in PNB Bank.
Does	he	work	in PNB Bank.



Present Continuous

How to identify

वाक्यों के अंत में रहा है, रही है, रहे है इत्यादि शब्द आते है। जैसे

- मैं PNB बैंक में काम कर रहा हूँ।

Rules

Subject + Is/Are/Am + 1st form of verb + Ing + Object

SUBJECT	IS/ARE/AM	VERB	REST OF THE SENTENCE
I	am	working	in PNB Bank.
You	are	working	in PNB Bank.
We	are	working	in PNB Bank.
They	are	working	in PNB Bank.
Rohan	is	working	in PNB Bank.
He	is	working	in PNB Bank.



Negative

Rules

Subject + Is/Are/Am +Not + 1st form of verb + ing + Object

Example

SUBJECT	IS/ARE/AM	NEGATIVE	VERB	REST OF THE SENTENCE
I	am	not	working	in PNB Bank.
You	are	not	working	in PNB Bank.
We	are	not	working	in PNB Bank.
They	are	not	working	in PNB Bank.
Rohan	is	not	working	in PNB Bank.
He	is	not	working	in PNB Bank.



Interrogative

Rules

Is/Are/Am + Subject + 1st form of verb + ing + Object + Question Mark (?)

Example

INTERROGATIVE	SUBJECT	VERB	REST OF THE SENTENCE
Am	I	working	in PNB Bank?
Are	You	working	in PNB Bank?
Are	We	working	in PNB Bank?
Are	They	working	in PNB Bank?
Is	Rohan	working	in PNB Bank?
Is	He	working	in PNB Bank?



Present Perfect Tense

How to identify

वाक्यों के अंत में चुका है, चुकी है, चुके है शब्द आते हैं। जैसे

- मैं PNB बैंक में काम कर चुका हूँ।

Rules

Subject + Has/Have + Third Form of the Verb + Object

SUBJECT	HAS/HAVE	VERB 3rd FORM	REST OF THE SENTENCE
I	have	worked	in PNB Bank.
You	have	worked	in PNB Bank.
We	have	worked	in PNB Bank.
They	have	worked	in PNB Bank.
Rohan	has	worked	in PNB Bank.
He	has	worked	in PNB Bank.



Negative

Subject + Has/Have + Not + Third Form of the Verb + Object

SUBJECT	HAS/HAVE	NEGATIVE	VERB 3rd FORM	REST OF THE SENTENCE
I	have	not	worked	in PNB Bank.
You	have	not	worked	in PNB Bank.
We	have	not	worked	in PNB Bank.
They	have	not	worked	in PNB Bank.
Rohan	has	not	worked	in PNB Bank.
He	has	not	worked	in PNB Bank.



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Interrogative

Has/Have + Subject + Third Form of the Verb + Object + Question Mark (?)

HAS/HAVE	SUBJECT	VERB 3rd FORM	REST OF THE SENTENCE
Has	I	worked	in PNB Bank?
Has	you	worked	in PNB Bank?
Has	we	worked	in PNB Bank?
Has	they	worked	in PNB Bank?
Have	Rohan	worked	in PNB Bank?
Have	he	worked	in PNB Bank?



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Present Perfect Continuous Tense

वाक्यों के अंत में रहा है, रही है, रहे है शब्द आते है एवं समय आता है।

For example

- वह 2 घंटे से खेल रहा है।

Rules

Subject + Has/Have Been + 1st Form of the Verb + ing + Object + Since/For + Time

Example

SUBJECT	HAD BEEN	1ST FORM OF VERB + ING	OBJECT	SINCE/FOR	TIME
I	have been	playing	cricket	for	2 hours.
You	have been	playing	cricket	for	2 hours.
We	have been	playing	cricket	for	2 hours.
They	have been	playing	cricket	for	2 hours.
Rohan	has been	playing	cricket	for	2 hours.
He	has been	playing	cricket	for	2 hours.



Note:

Since का प्रयोग निश्चित समय के लिए होता है जैसे २ बजे से , रविवार से , जून से , 2012 से etc.

For का प्रयोग अनिश्चित समय के लिए होता है जैसे 4 घंटे से , 10 दिन से, कई वर्षों से etc.

Negative

Rules

Subject + Has/Have + Not + Been + 1st Form of the Verb + ing + Object + Since/For + Time

Example

SUBJECT	HAD NOT BEEN	1ST FORM OF VERB + ING	OBJECT	SINCE/FOR	TIME
I	have not been	playing	cricket	for	2 hours.
You	have not been	playing	cricket	for	2 hours.
We	have not been	playing	cricket	for	2 hours.
They	have not been	playing	cricket	for	2 hours.
Rohan	has not been	playing	cricket	for	2 hours.



Interrogative

Rules

Has/Have + Subject + Been + 1st Form of the Verb + Ing + Object + Since/For + Time + Question Mark (?)

Example

HAD	SUBJECT	BEEN	1ST FORM OF VERB + ING	OBJECT	SINCE/FOR	TIME
Have	I	been	playing	cricket	for	2 hours?
Have	you	been	playing	cricket	for	2 hours?
Have	we	been	playing	cricket	for	2 hours?
Have	they	been	playing	cricket	for	2 hours?
Has	Rohan	been	playing	cricket	for	2 hours?
Has	he	been	playing	cricket	for	2 hours?



Past Indefinite

How to identify

इस Tense के वाक्यों के अंत में था , थी , थे , या , यी , ये आदि आते हैं।

Rules

Subject + 2nd Form of the Verb + Object

Example

SUBJECT	VERB	OBJECT
I	worked	In PNB bank.
You	worked	In PNB bank.
We	worked	In PNB bank.
They	worked	In PNB bank.
Rohan	worked	In PNB bank.
He	worked	In PNB bank.

Here , we use 2nd form of the verb for all subjects.



Negative Sentences

Rules

Subject + did not + 1st Form of the Verb + Object

Example

SUBJECT	NEGATIVE	VERB	OBJECT
I	did not	work	In PNB bank.
You	did not	work	In PNB bank.
We	did not	work	In PNB bank.
They	did not	work	In PNB bank.
Rohan	did not	work	In PNB bank.
He	did not	work	In PNB bank.

Here , we use 'did not' for all subjects.



Interrogative Sentence

Rules

Did + Subject + 1st Form of the Verb + Object+ Question Mark(?)

Example

INTERROGATIVE	SUBJECT	VERB	OBJECT
Did	I	work	in PNB bank?
Did	you	work	in PNB bank?
Did	we	work	in PNB bank?
Did	they	work	in PNB bank?
Did	Rohan	work	in PNB bank?
Did	he	work	in PNB bank?

Here, we use 'did' for all subjects.



Past Continuous

How to identify

वाक्यों के अंत में रहा था , रही थी, रहे थे शब्द आते हैं।

Rules

Subject + Was/Were + First form of Verb + ing + Object

Example

SUBJECT	WAS/WERE	VERB + ING	OBJECT
I	was	watching	a movie.
You	were	watching	a movie.
We	were	watching	a movie.
They	were	watching	a movie.
Rohan	was	watching	a movie.
He	was	watching	a movie.

Here, we use 'Was' for I, Rohan and for He subject and used 'Were' for You, We and They Subject.



Negative Sentences

Rules

Subject + Was/Were not + 1st Form of the Verb + ing + Object

Example

SUBJECT	WAS/WERE	NEGATIVE	VERB + ING	OBJECT
I	was	not	watching	a movie.
You	were	not	watching	a movie.
We	were	not	watching	a movie.
They	were	not	watching	a movie.
Rohan	was	not	watching	a movie.
He	was	not	watching	a movie.



Interrogative Sentence

Rules

Was/Were + Subject + 1st Form of the Verb + ing + Object + Question Mark(?)

Example

INTERROGATIVE	SUBJECT	VERB + ING	OBJECT
Was	I	watching	a movie?
Were	you	watching	a movie?
Were	we	watching	a movie?
Were	they	watching	a movie?
Was	Rohan	watching	a movie?
Was	he	watching	a movie?



Past Perfect Tense

How to identify

वाक्यों के अंत में चुका , चुकी थी, चुके थे शब्द आते हैं।

Rules

Subject + Had + Third form of Verb + Object

Example

SUBJECT	HAD	VERB + 3 RD FORM	OBJECT
I	had	watched	the movie.
You	had	watched	the movie.
We	had	watched	the movie.
They	had	watched	the movie.
Rohan	had	watched	the movie.
He	had	watched	the movie.



Negative Sentences

Rules

Subject + Had not + 3rd Form of the Verb + Object

Example

SUBJECT	HAD	NEGATIVE	VERB + 3 RD FORM	OBJECT
I	had	not	watched	the movie.
You	had	not	watched	the movie.
We	had	not	watched	the movie.
They	had	not	watched	the movie.
Rohan	had	not	watched	the movie.
He	had	not	watched	the movie.



Interrogative Sentence

Rules

Subject + Had not + 3rd Form of the Verb + Object + Question Mark(?)

Example

INTERROGATIVE	SUBJECT	VERB + 3 RD FORM	OBJECT
Had	I	watched	the movie?
Had	you	watched	the movie?
Had	we	watched	the movie?
Had	they	watched	the movie?
Had	Rohan	watched	the movie?
Had	he	watched	the movie?



Past Perfect Continuous

How to identify

वाक्यों के अंत में रहा था , रही थी, रहे थे शब्द आते हैं एवं समय आता है। For example –

- वह 2 घंटे से खेल रहा था।

Rules

Subject + Had Been + 1st Form of the Verb + Ing + Object + Since/For + Time

Example

SUBJECT	HAD BEEN	1 ST FORM OF VERB + ING	OBJECT	SINCE/FOR	TIME
I	had been	playing	cricket	for	2 hours.
You	had been	playing	cricket	for	2 hours.
We	had been	playing	cricket	for	2 hours.
They	had been	playing	cricket	for	2 hours.
Rohan	had been	playing	cricket	for	2 hours.
He	had been	playing	cricket	for	2 hours.



Note:

Since का प्रयोग निश्चित समय के लिए होता है जैसे २ बजे से , रविवार से , जून से , 2012 से etc.

Rules

Subject + Had + Not + Been + 1st Form of the Verb + Ing + Object + Since/For + Time

Example

SUBJECT	HAD NOT BEEN	1 ST FORM OF VERB + ING	OBJECT	SINCE/FOR	TIME
I	had not been	playing	cricket	for	2 hours.
You	had not been	playing	cricket	for	2 hours.
We	had not been	playing	cricket	for	2 hours.
They	had not been	playing	cricket	for	2 hours.
Rohan	had not been	playing	cricket	for	2 hours.
He	had not been	playing	cricket	for	2 hours.

Had + Subject + Been + 1st Form of the Verb + Ing + Object + Since/For + Time + Question Mark (?)

Future Indefinite

How to identify

इस Tense के वाक्यों के अंत में गा, गी, गे आते हैं। जैसे: - मैं गाना गाऊँगा।

Rules

Subject + Shall/Will + 1st form of the Verb + Object

Example

SUBJECT	SHALL/WILL	1 ST FORM OF VERB	OBJECT
I	shall	sing	a song.
You	will	sing	a song.
We	shall	sing	a song.
They	will	sing	a song.
Rohan	will	sing	a song.
He	will	sing	a song.

Note: Here, with **I and We** helping verb '**shall**' will be used and with other subjects '**will**' will be used.



Negative

Rules

Subject + Shall/Will + Not + 1st form of the Verb + Object

Example

SUBJECT	SHALL/WILL	NEGATIVE	1 ST FORM OF VERB	OBJECT
I	shall	not	sing	a song.
You	will	not	sing	a song.

Subject + Shall/Will + Be + 1st Form of Verb + ing + Object

SUBJECT	SHALL/WILL	BE	1 ST FORM OF VERB	OBJECT
I	shall	be	singing	a song.
You	will	be	singing	a song.
We	shall	be	singing	a song.
They	will	be	singing	a song.
Rohan	will	be	singing	a song.
He	will	be	singing	a song.

Subjects + Shall/Will + Have + 3rd Form of Verb + Object.

Example

SUBJECT	SHALL/WILL	HAVE	3 RD FORM OF VERB	OBJECT
I	shall	have	sung	the song.
You	will	have	sung	the song.
We	shall	have	sung	the song.
They	will	have	sung	the song.
Rohan	will	have	sung	the song.
He	will	have	sung	the song.



Note: Here, with **I and We** helping verb '**shall**' will be used and with other subjects '**will**' will be used.

Negative

Rules

Subjects + Shall/Will + Not + Have + 3rd Form of Verb + Object.

Example

SUBJECT	SHALL/WILL	NEGATIVE	HAVE	3 RD FORM OF VERB	OBJECT
I	shall	not	have	sung	the song.
You	will	not	have	sung	the song.
We	shall	not	have	sung	the song.

Future Perfect Continuous

How to identify

इस वाक्य के अंत में रहा होगा , रही होगी , रहे होंगे के साथ समय दिया होता है। जैसे

- वह २ बजे से गाना गा रहा होगा।

Rules

Subject + Shall/Will + Have been + 1st Form of Verb + Ing + Object + Since/For + Time.

Example

SUBJECT	SHALL/WILL	HAVE BEEN	1 ST VERB + ING	OBJECT	SINCE/FOR	TIME
I	shall	have been	singing	a song	since	2 O'clock.
You	will	have been	singing	a song	since	2 O'clock.
We	shall	have been	singing	a song	since	2 O'clock.
They	will	have been	singing	a song	since	2 O'clock.
Rohan	will	have been	singing	a song	since	2 O'clock.
He	will	have been	singing	a song	since	2 O'clock.

Note: Here, with **I and We** helping verb '**shall**' will be used and with other subjects '**will**' will be used.

Subject + Shall/Will + Not + Have been + 1st Form of Verb + Ing + Object + Since/For + Time.

Shall	I	have been	singing	a song	since	2 O'clock?
Will	you	have been	singing	a song	since	2 O'clock?
Shall	we	have been	singing	a song	since	2 O'clock?
Will	they	have been	singing	a song	since	2 O'clock?
Will	Rohan	have been	singing	a song	since	2 O'clock?
Will	he	have been	singing	a song	since	2 O'clock?

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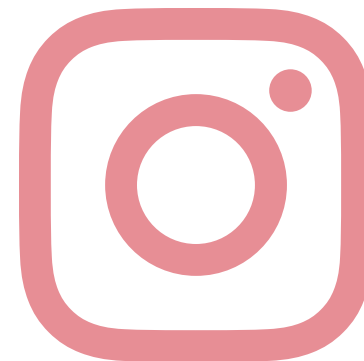
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
